Michelangelo Bortolin currently works as an emergency physician for the Servizio Emergenza Territoriale 118 of Torino (Emergency Medical Services 118 - Torino, Italy), in addition to serving as a faculty member of the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center (BIDMC) Fellowship in Disaster Medicine (Boston, USA) and as a member of the Clinical Advisory Board with Dianax (Milan, Italy).

He was a Research Fellow in Disaster Medicine and EMS in the Disaster Medicine Section of the Harvard Medical School in Boston led by Professor Gregory R. Ciottone. He served as a healthcare advisor for governmental agencies such as the European Commission's Research Executive Agency (REA), World Health Organization (WHO), and private sector companies (from start-ups to companies with Mkt Cap >50B) including Tykli, a company that utilizes big data and semantic web technologies, and for Medilink International, a Malta-based company that provides global medical support, remote medical services, OHS, medevac, training, consulting, and policy development to clients ranging from large oil corporations to public sector entities.

From 2007 to the present, Dr. Bortolin has worked as an Adjunct Professor (23 annual contracts) and as Graduate Teaching Assistant (16 annual contracts) with several Italian Universities, and Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele - Milano, Università di Torino, Università degli Studi Milano, and Università degli Studi Milano Bicocca.

He has been invited as a Speaker or Chair at several Congresses in Italy and in different cities globally, including Boston, Tokyo, Davao (Philippines), Jeddah (Saudi Arabia), and Manchester. Dr. Bortolin has authored several books, including one with the WHO, and other publications.
